**Joshua: Strength and Courage**

**Before the Lord**

**Joshua 18-19**

Chapters 18-19 continues the allotment of land to the tribes. An interesting change in location occurs in chapter 18. The people of Israel assemble at Shiloh. It is at Shiloh that the people erect the tent of meeting. Shiloh becomes the location of worship of God for the next 369 years. Worship of God at the tent of meeting is an expression of God's dominion and mission.
