When God wants to convey the depth of His care for His people, He chooses a universally understood illustration: a mother. Mothers are glorious gifts from God, whom He gifted with unique abilities to comfort her children. Just as mothers comfort their children, so God comforts His. It is a reminder that God is a personal and involved God who loves His children.
